



My Haircut Day

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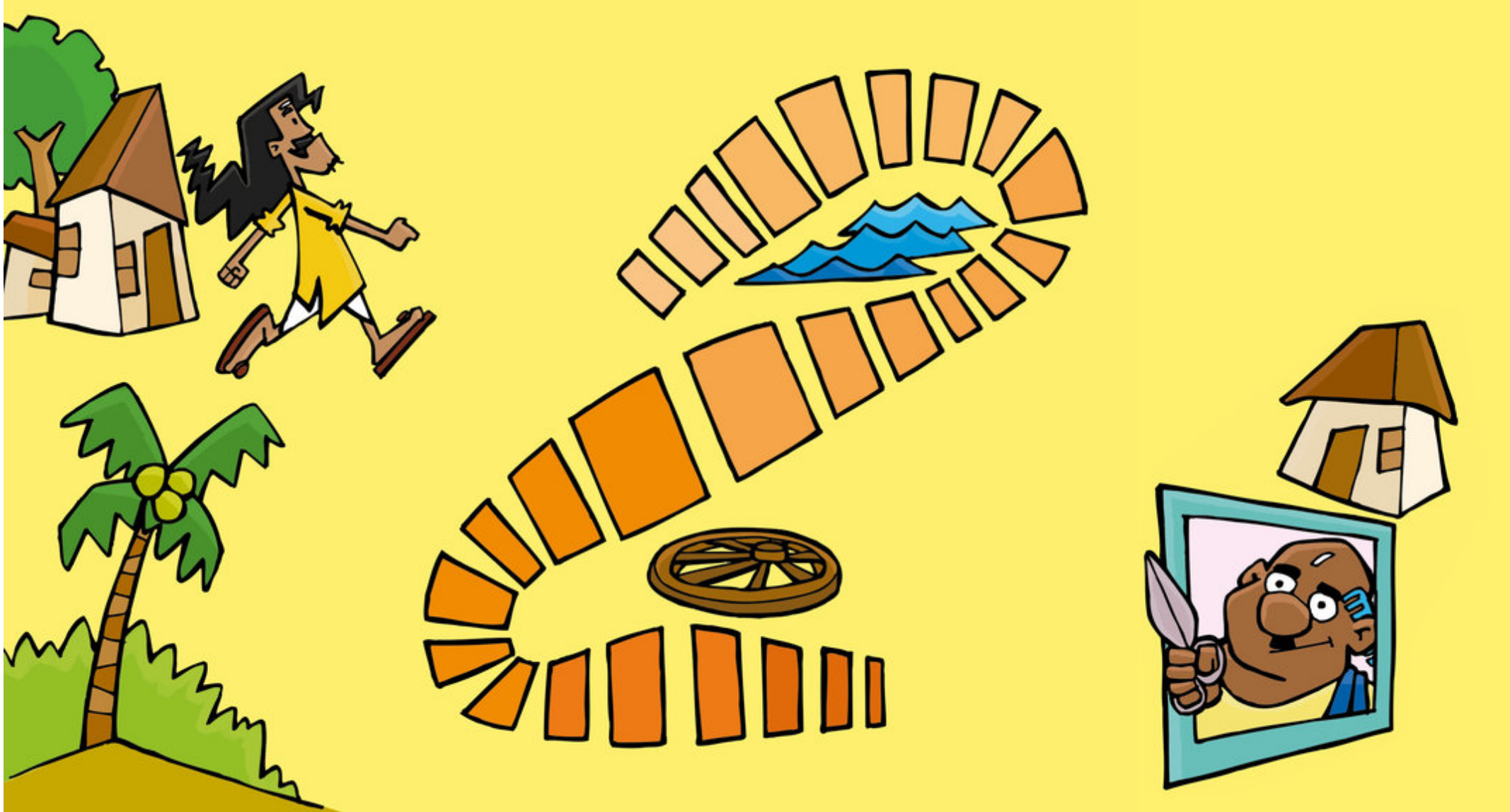
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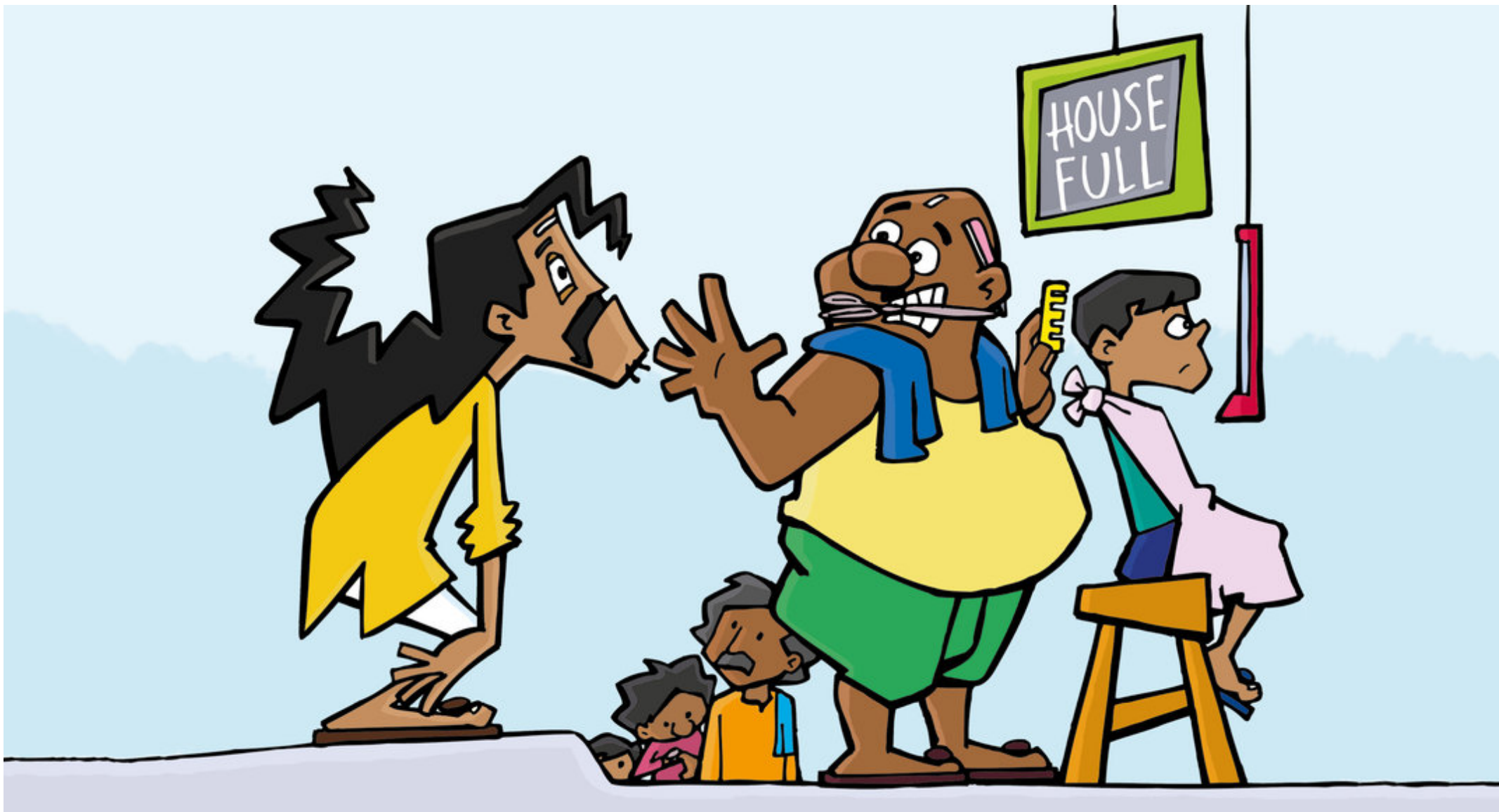
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It is Haircut Day for Ram.



Ram walks to the barber.



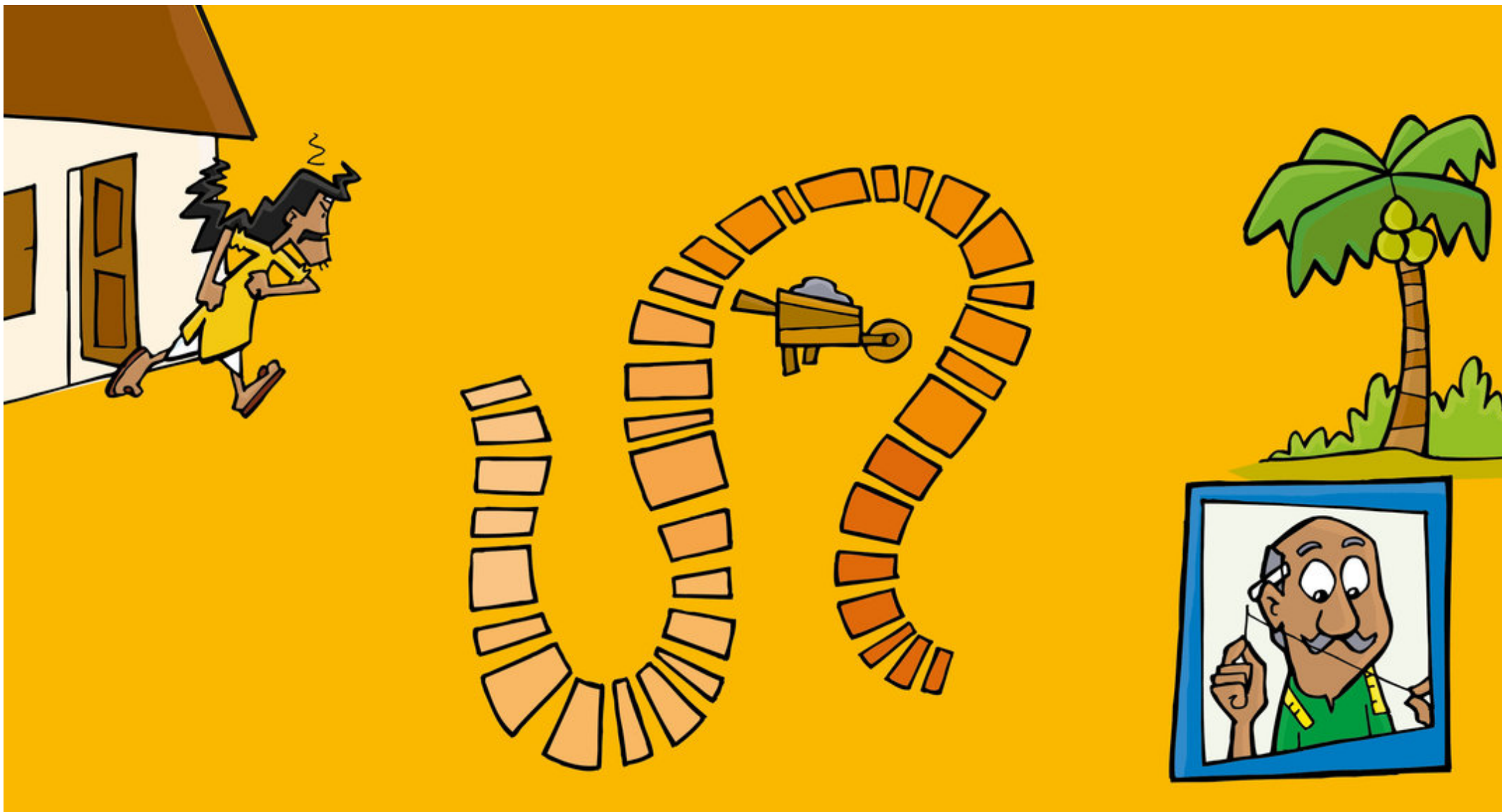
The barber says, "I have no time to cut such long hair."



Ram is sad. He walks home to his family.



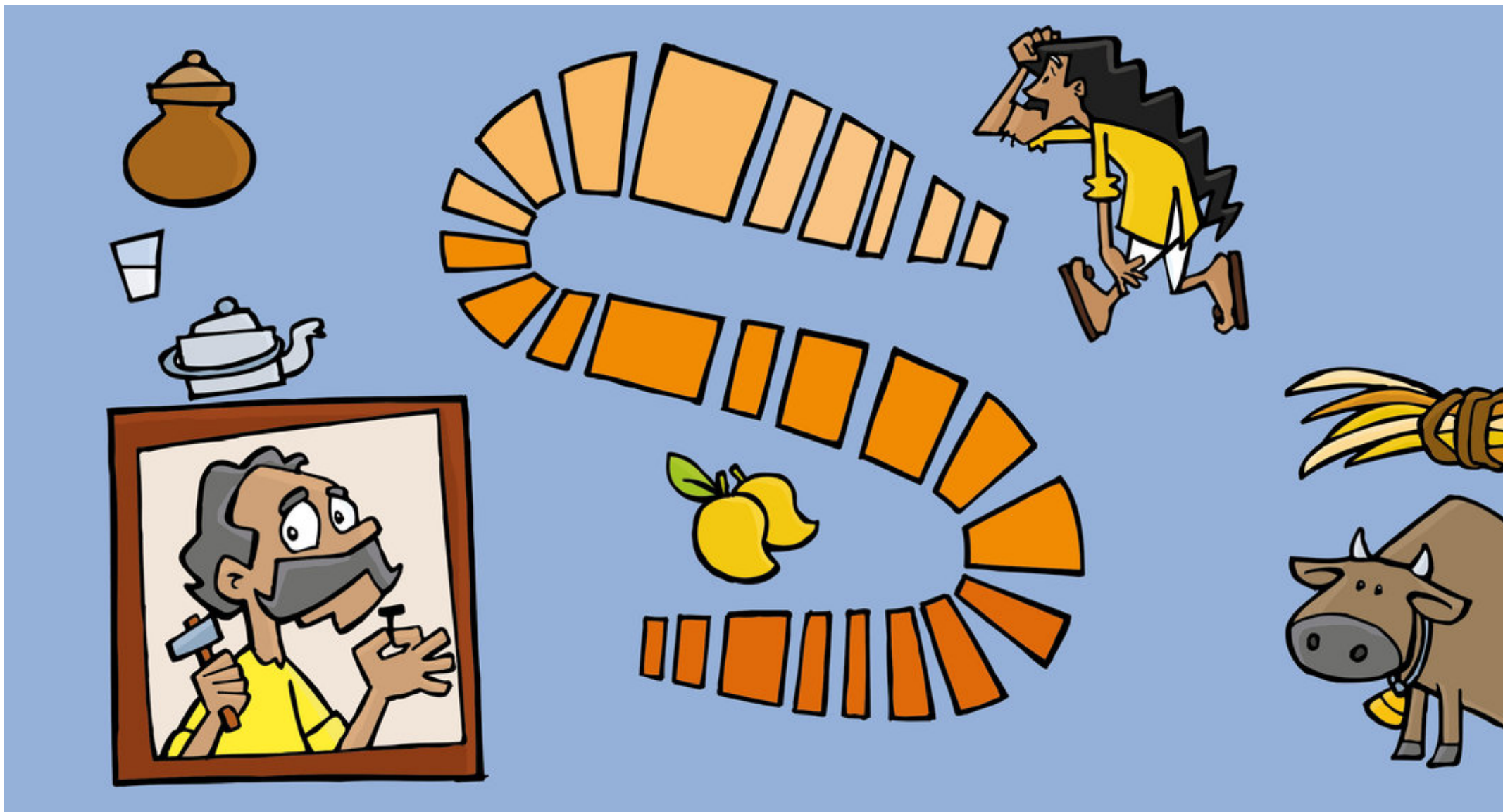
His wife says, "I have no time to cut such long hair."

Ram is so sad, he walks into the forest.



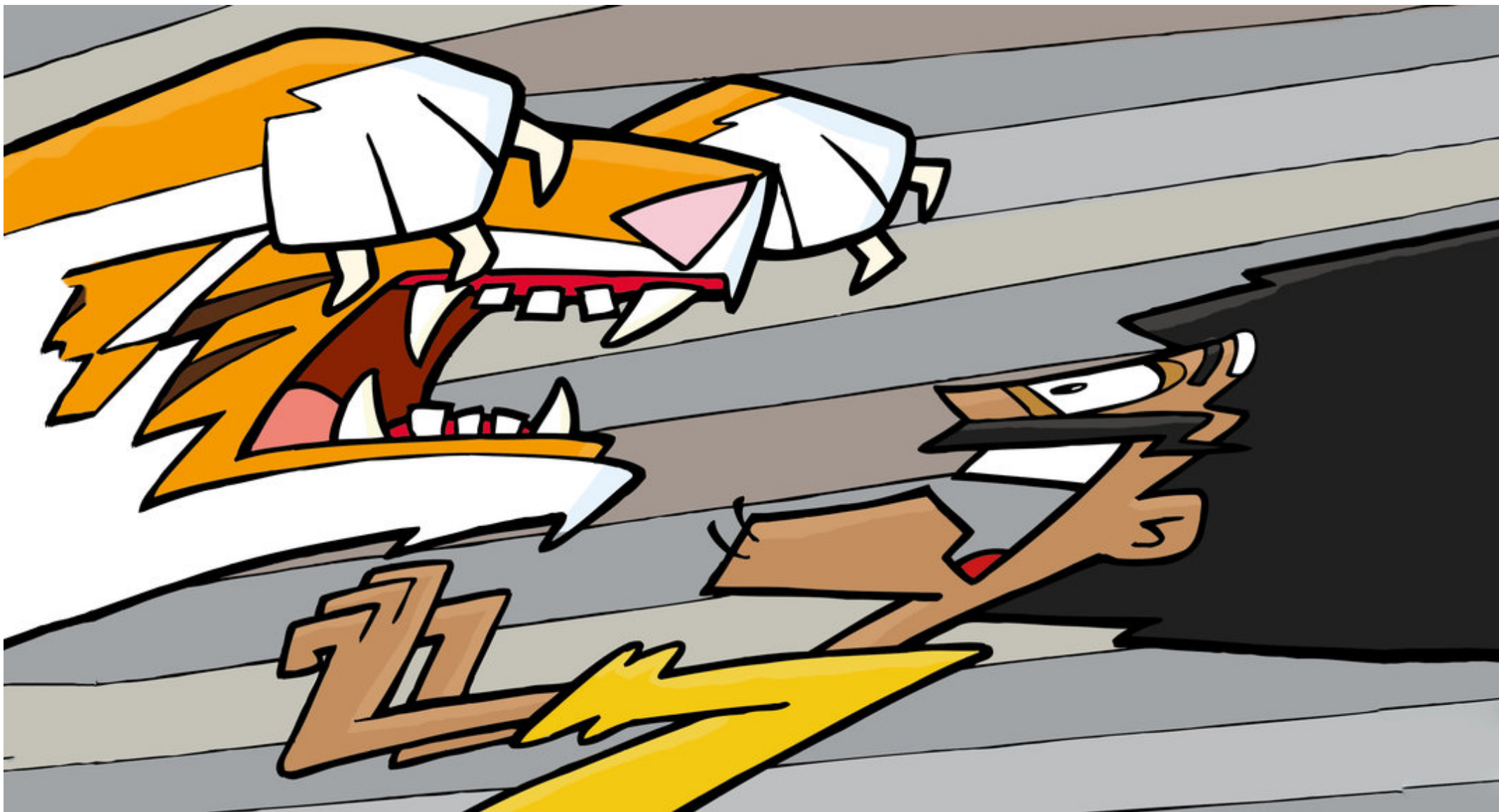
Ram lies down and cries.



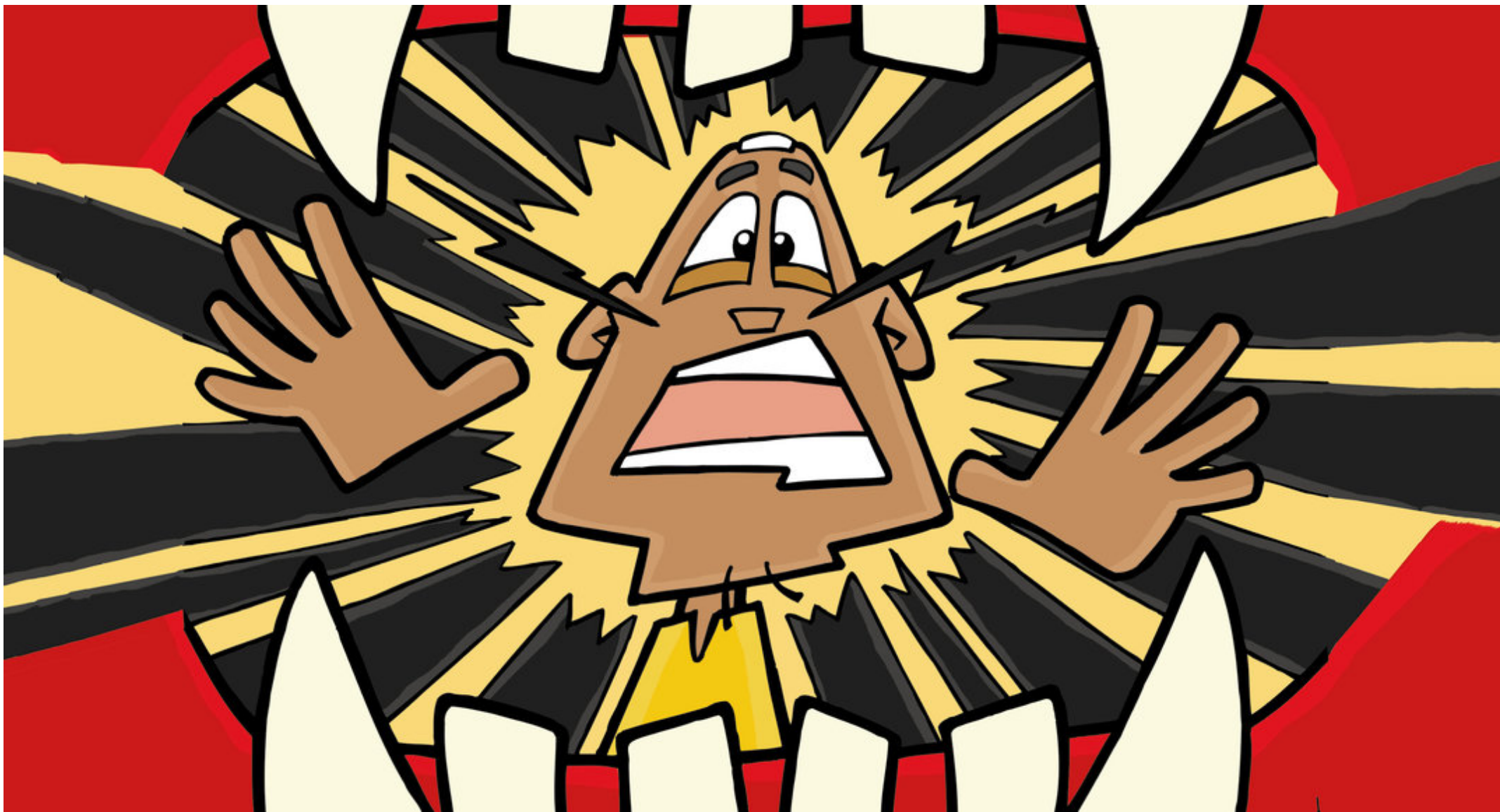
A tiger does not like the noise.

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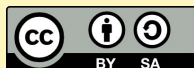
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
