This book tells about when Kim, Peg, and Ram go to the pond to see frogs with the robot frog.



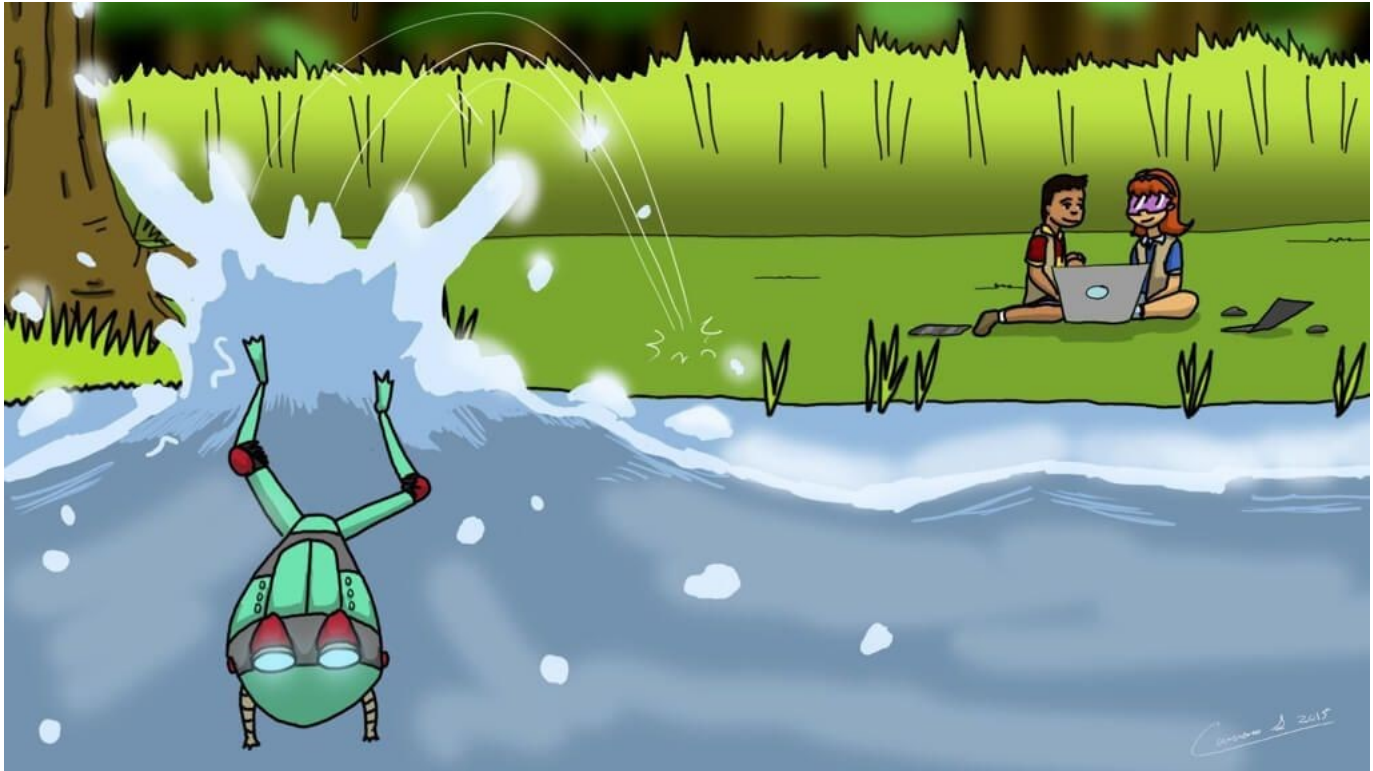
Kim, Peg, and Ram want to learn about frogs and tell their classmates.



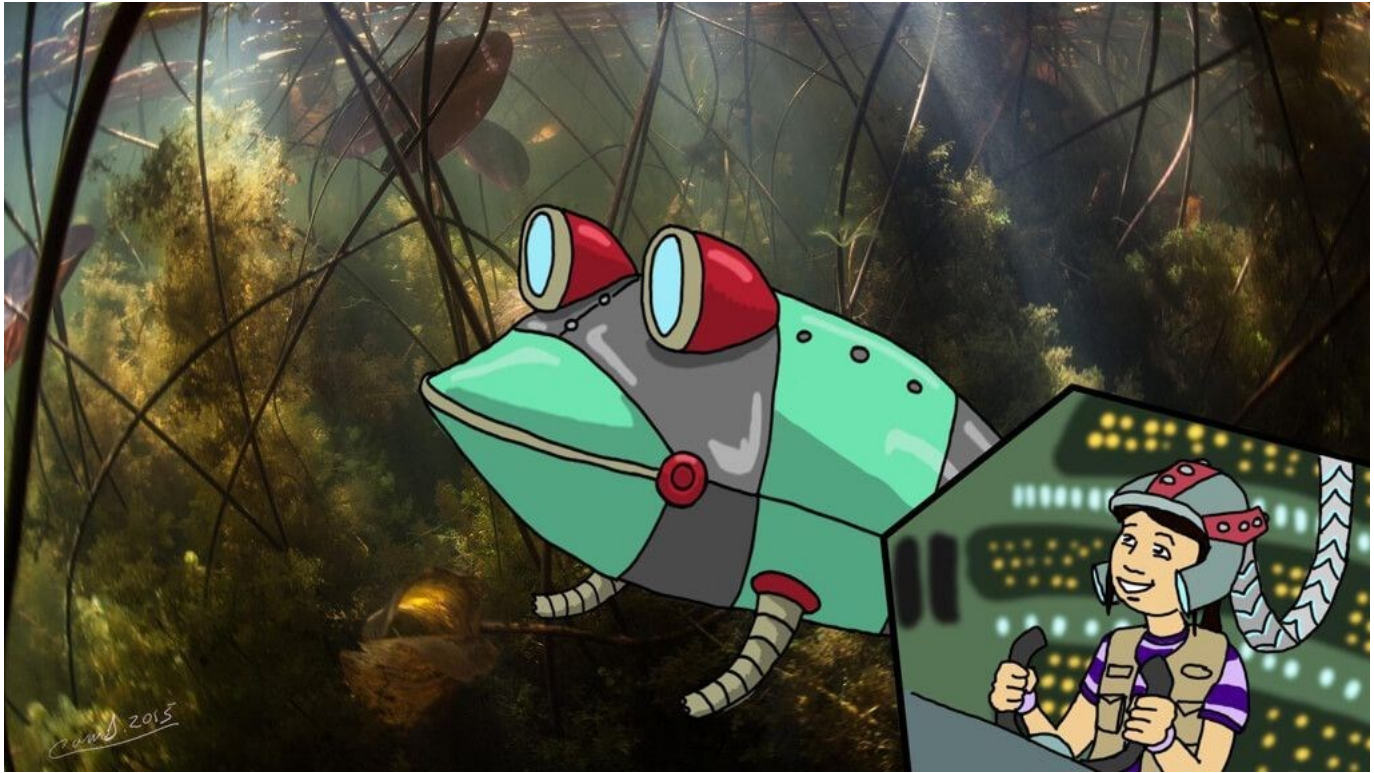
See the robot frog. It is big!



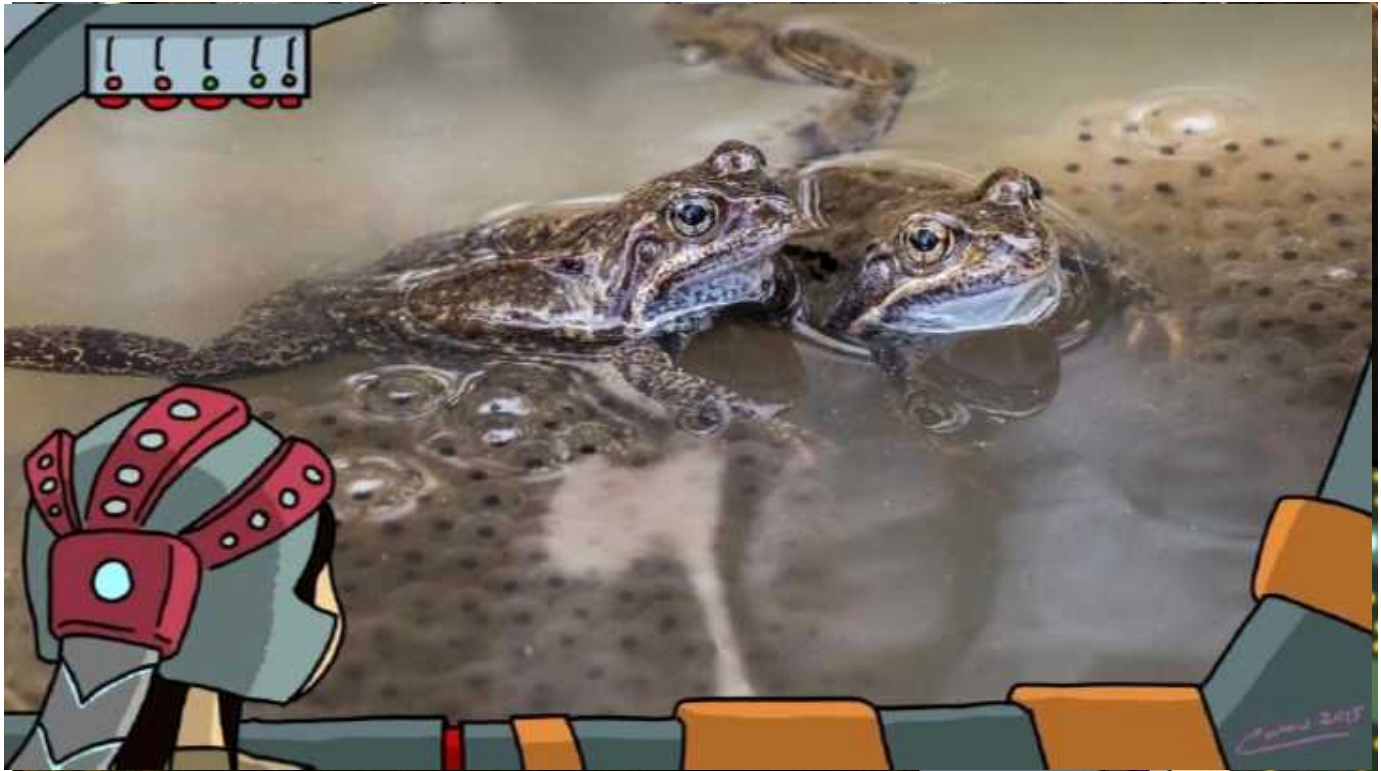
ZAP! ZAP! The robot frog gets little.



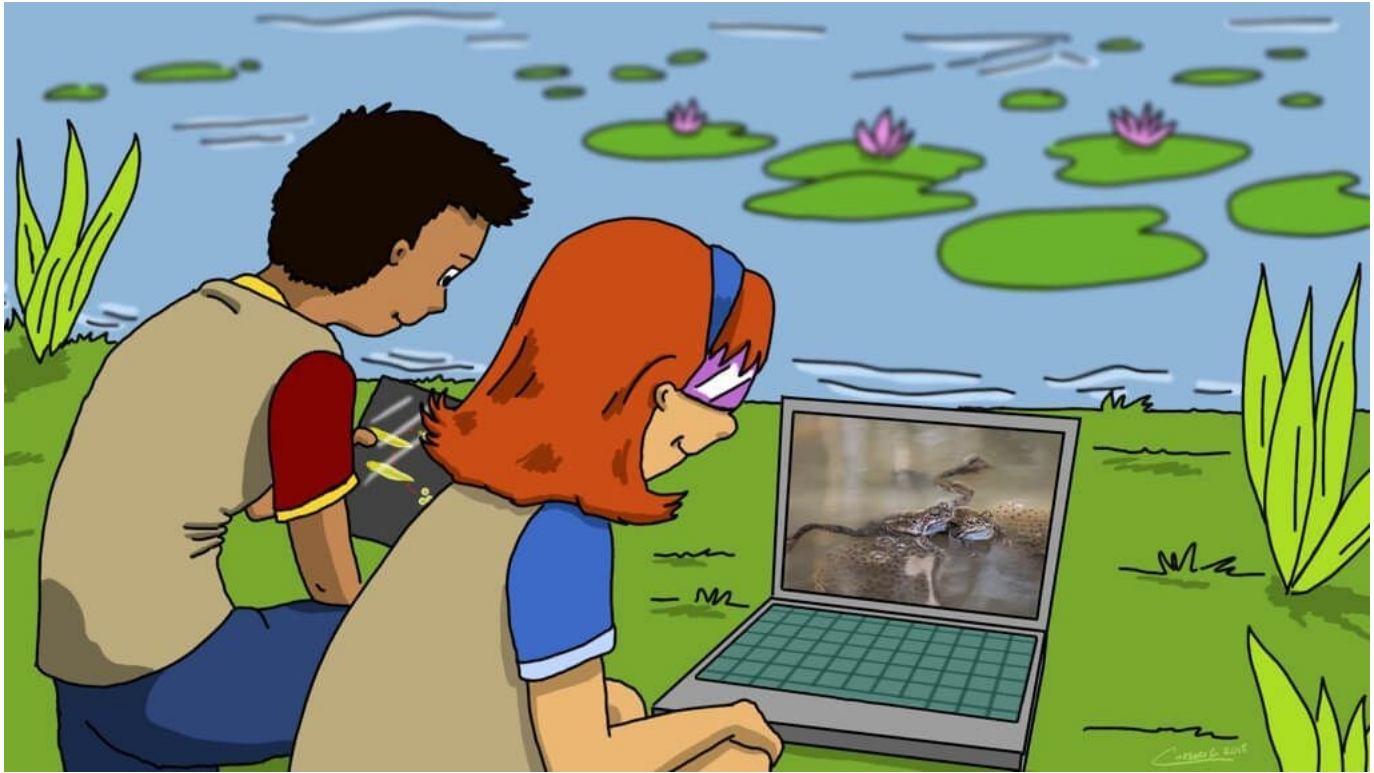
The robot frog hops into the pond.

Kim sees 2 frogs on top of the pond.



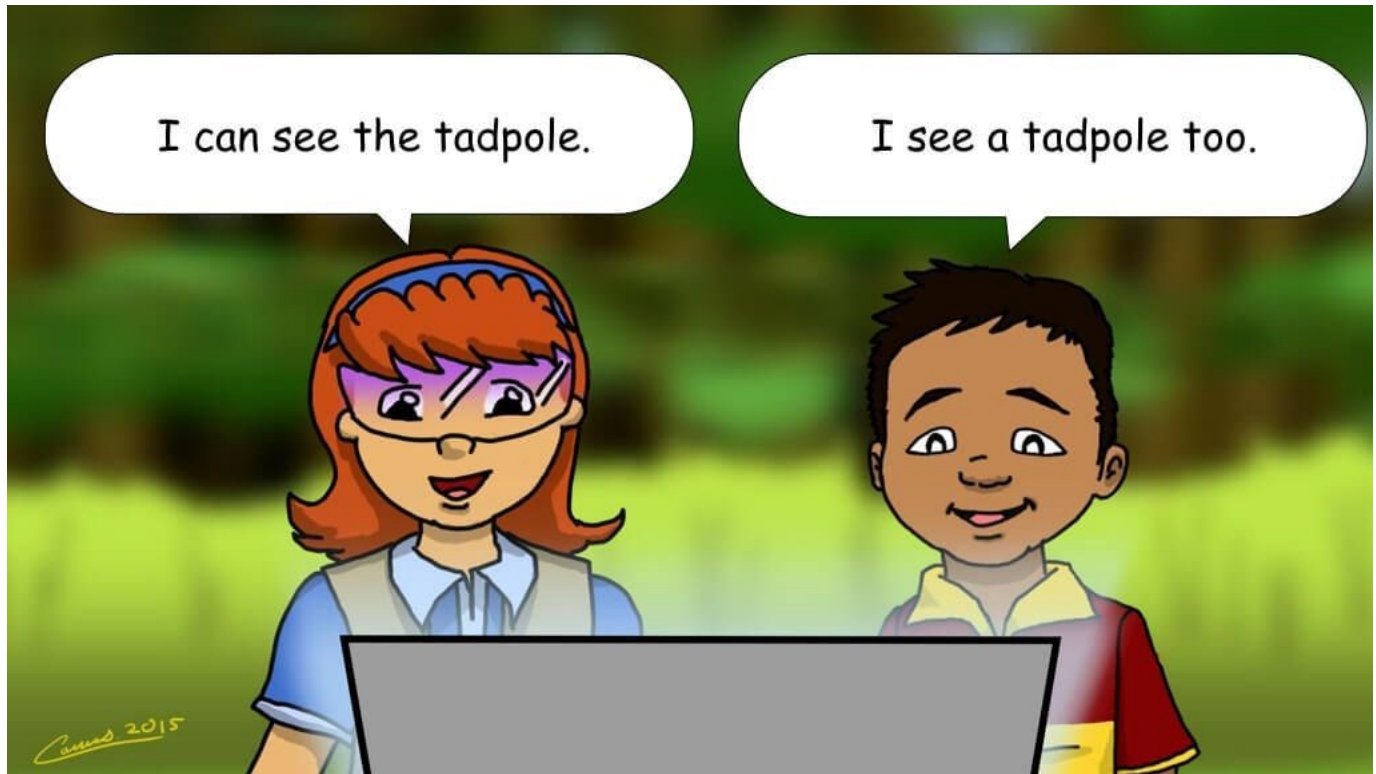
Ram and Peg can see the frogs, too.

Kim sees a tadpole. It swims in the pond. It has a long tail.



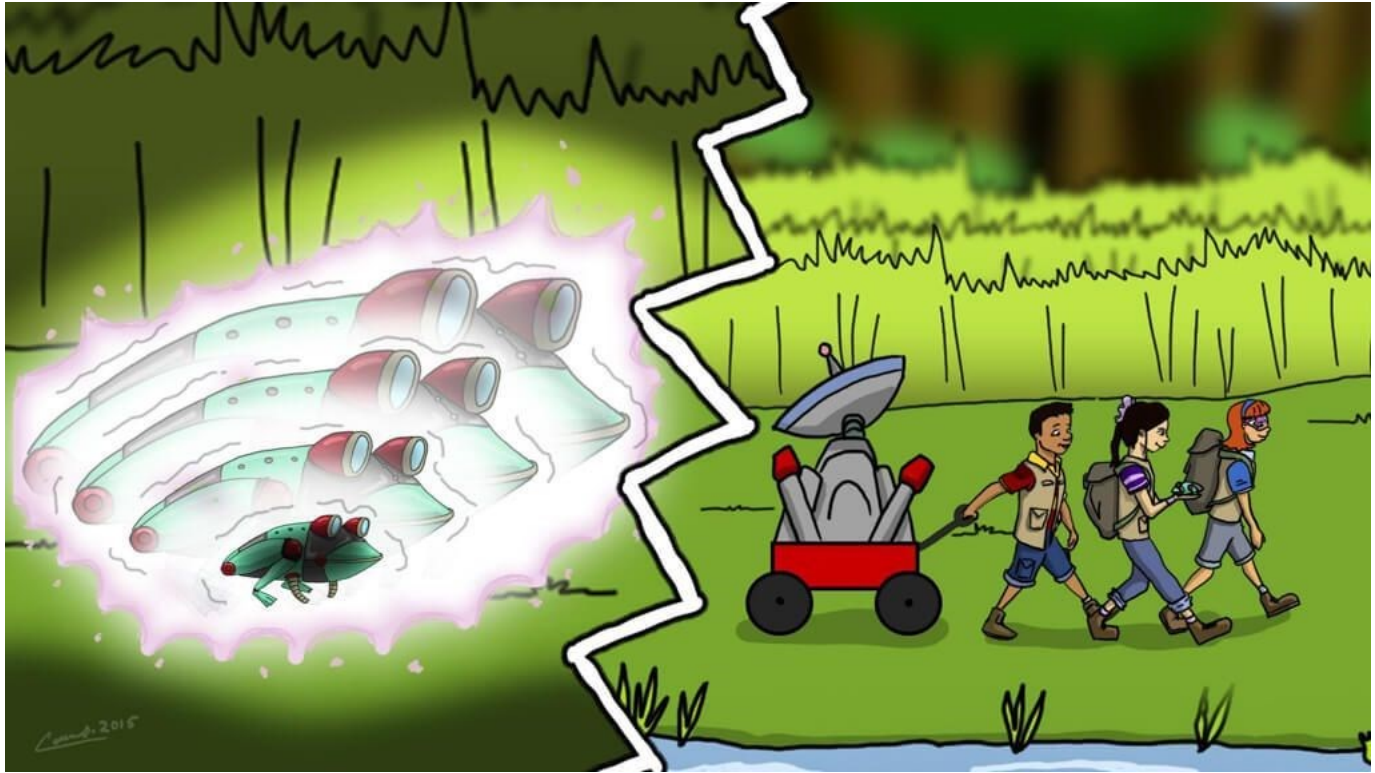
Peg and Ram can see the tadpole, too.



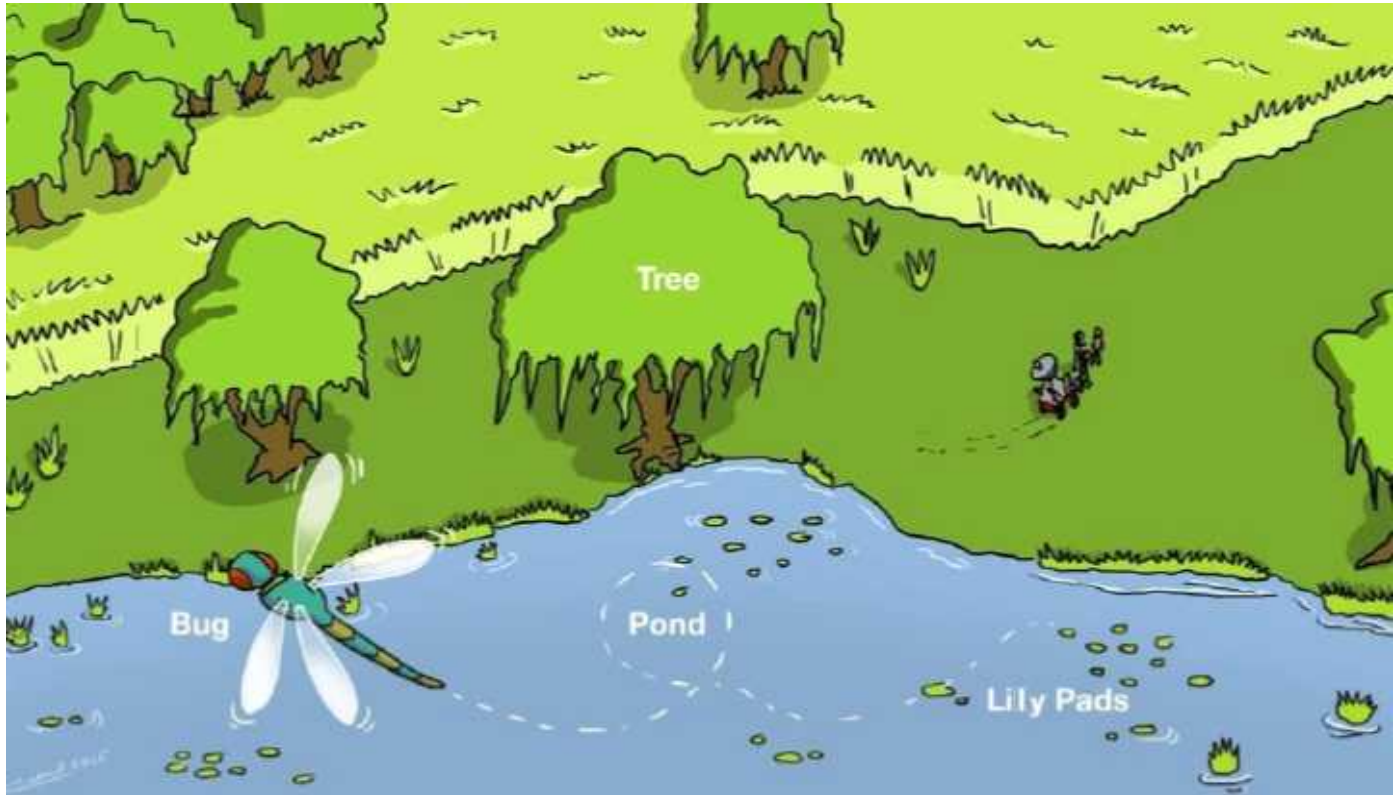
What can Kim see? It swims but it has back legs.

ZAP! ZAP! The robot frog gets big. Kim gets big, too. Kim is o.k.!

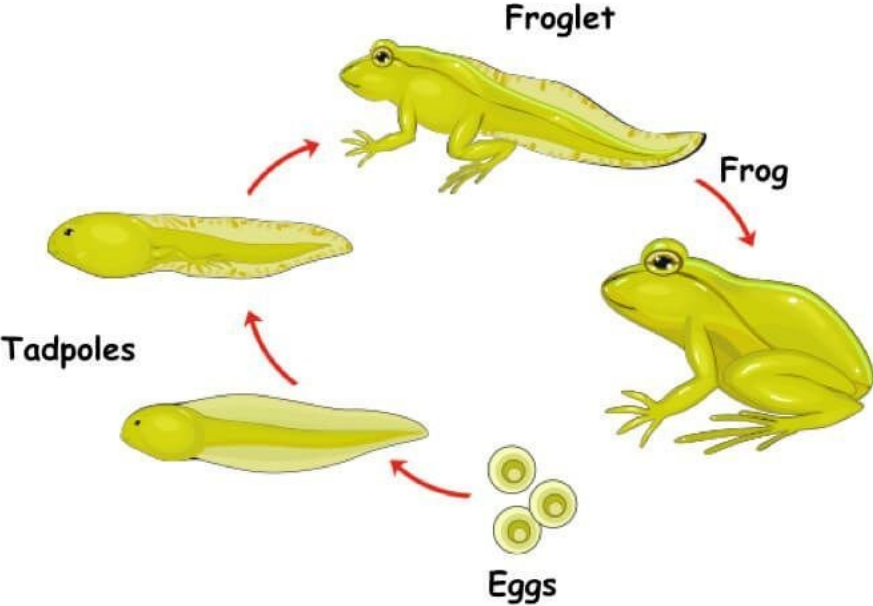


Peg, Kim, Ram, and the robot frog go from the pond. They can tell about the frogs.

Facts about Frogs

Frogs live where it is wet. Frogs eat bugs. They catch bugs with their tongue. They lay their eggs where it is wet. Frogs grow and change. As a tadpole they have gills to breathe under water, but as an adult they have lungs to breathe the air. As a tadpole they have a tail to swim, but as an adult they have legs to jump. There are fewer and fewer frogs because of toxins in the water.
