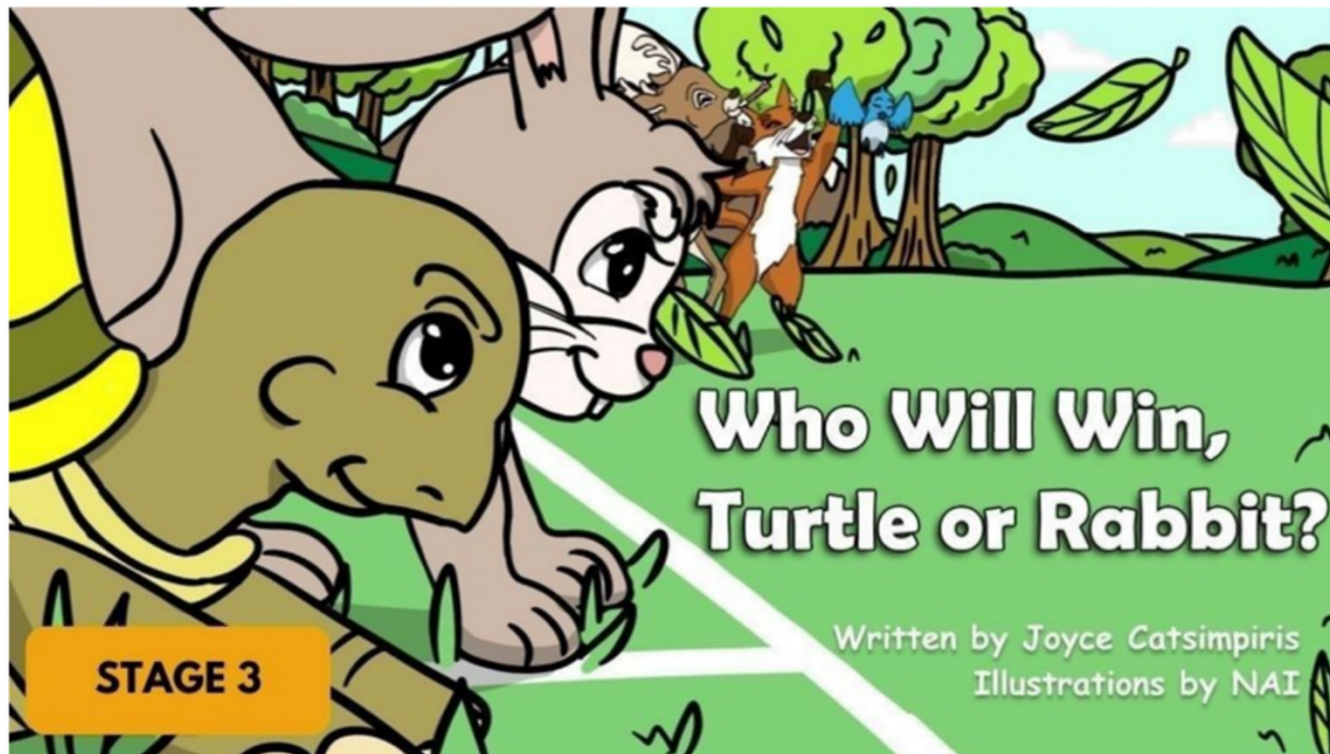
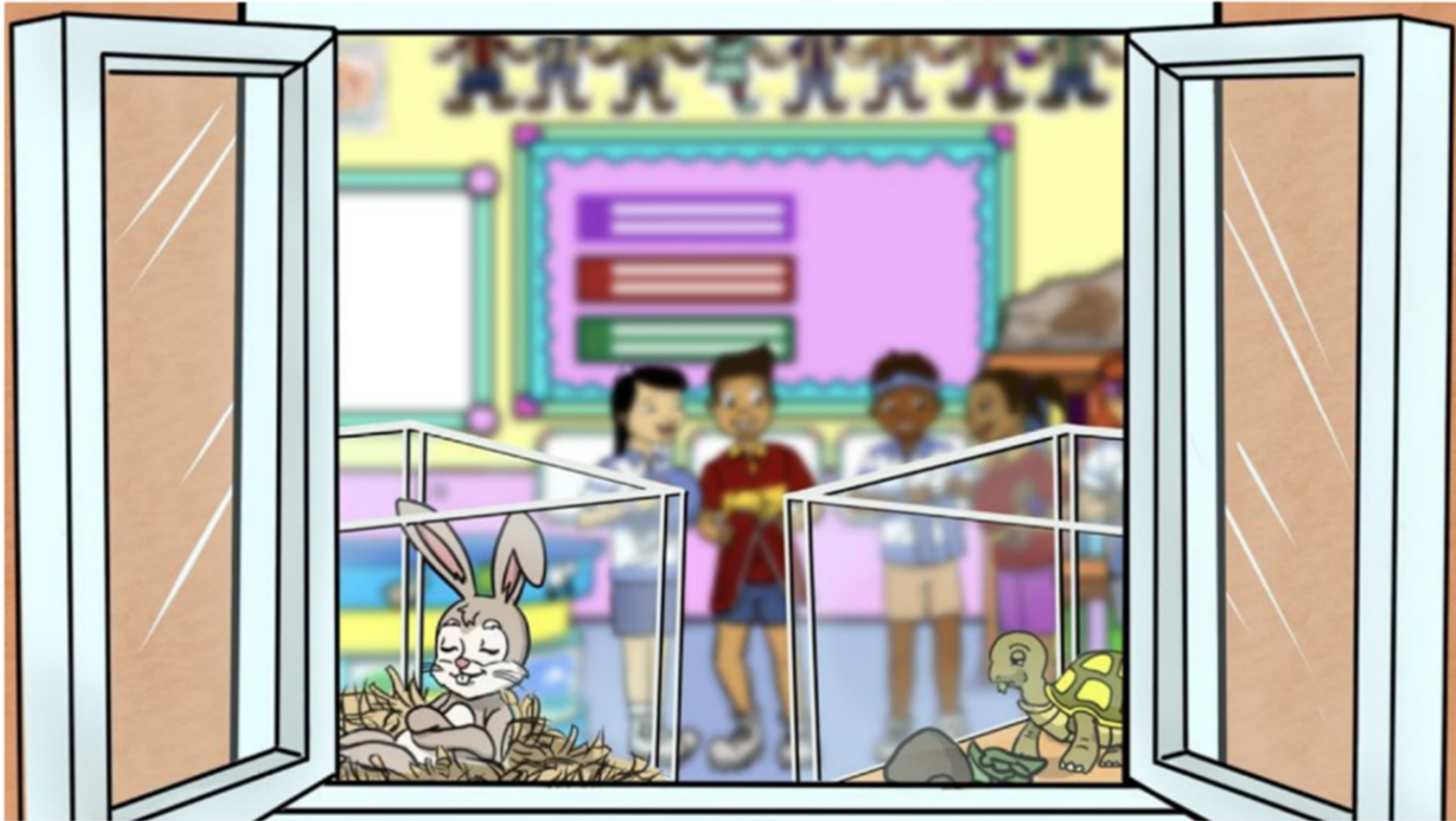


Nest Book

"I do not think Turtle can win," says Bird.

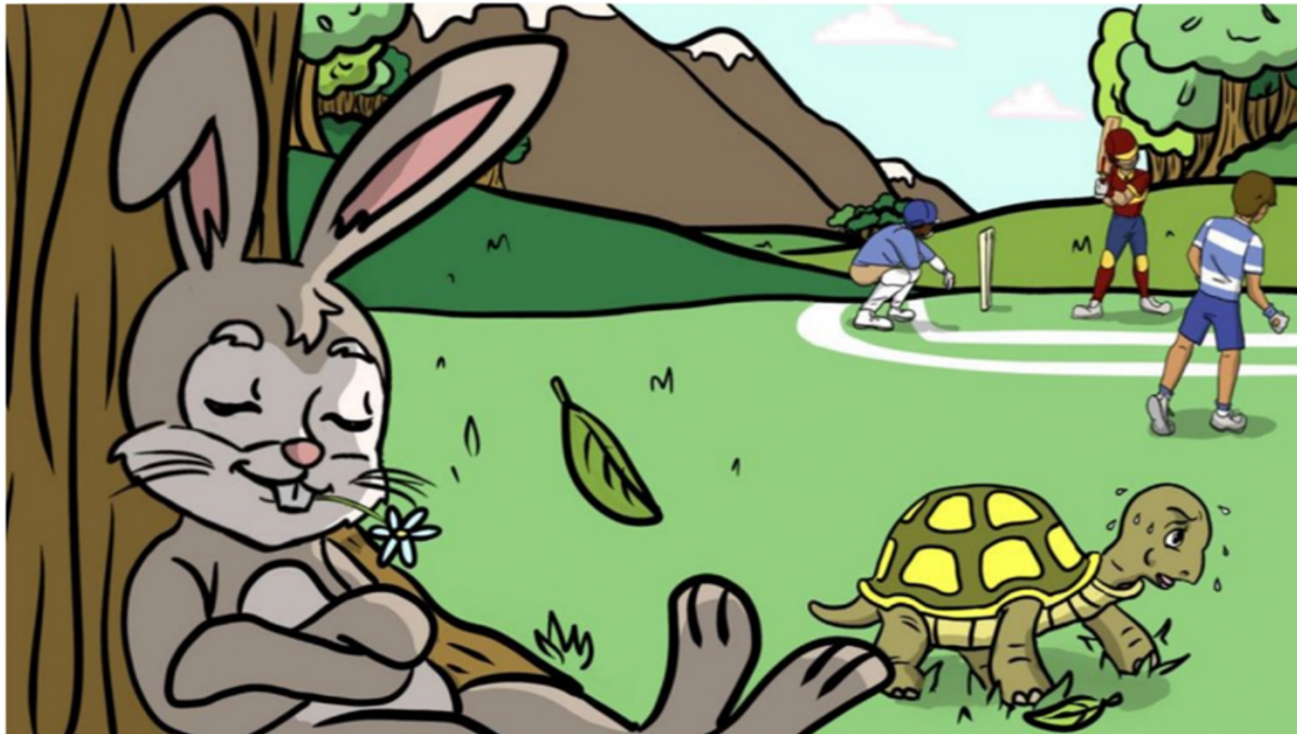
Fox says, "Get ready...GO!!" Rabbit jumps! He is running fast. Turtle is far behind Rabbit.
